# **QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER**

Player must have played a minimum of two full matches over a minimum of two (2) weeks in one session of any pool league sanctioned by the ACS within Iowa or an Iowa border state since 1/1/15. Any four players from the same league who meet these participation requirements may compose a 4-person team. If any team has more than one Open player on its roster, the team must enter the Open division (Standard Player = ISPA Level 2 without ever cashing; no out-of-state players allowed.). If any team has more than one national or state Advanced (ISPA Master 1, Masters, Grandmasters, or Elite) player on its roster, the team must enter the Advanced Team division. (Advanced Player = ACS, BCAPL, VNEA National Intermediate, Advanced or Master; any State Master from any state list as of 12/31/2014, including Iowa ACS, ISPA Level 1&2, IOMA, and ACS, BCAPL, Midwest, & VNEA; or "Known Ability".) CREDIBLE AND VERIFIABLE STATS MUST ACCOMPANY EACH ENTRY! MISREPRESENTATION OF STATS WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION!
